## WEEK 1 - The Wall (ch 4)

### Definition/Introduction

1. Have you ever been stuck? I was stuck once... in the snow. You can still find snow in April in Montana if you climb enough. We were driving up a mountain on an old country road in what looked to my California eyes to be a winter wonderland, when we strayed ever so slightly from the snow-covered trail and started slipping. The driver-side wheels of our truck, ironically called a Chevy Avalanche, slumped only a couple feet down off the trail on the left, but it was enough to get us stuck - tire-spinning stuck... If it wasn't for a good samaritan passing our way 15 minutes later, and the shovels he kept in the bed of his truck, we might not have got out. But even after he arrived, our work only began - we had to start digging...
2. God has designed our spiritual journey to work in a similar way. Sometimes, when we stray from the path, God places obstacles before us to force us to self-evaluate. Or, sometimes God places those obstacles right in the middle of the 'narrow way' because He knows we have hit a ceiling in our growth as Christians and can only now make progress by breaking through this 'wall'.

## Scripture + Questions

### BEING AT A WALL

1. Are there areas in your Christian walk where you feel stuck? That the tires are spinning? Perhaps in your prayer life, certain relationships, time in the word, or feelings in worship?

### GOD'S WORK IN US AT OUR WALL

1. What things or people are you rooting your identity in that God may want to dig up so that your identity might be replanted in him?
2. What is one thing God might want you to unlearn today?

### OUR RESPONSE TO BEING AT A WALL

1. Sometimes breaking through a wall requires a fresh commitment to God. Read the following scriptures about Paul's faithfulness to God and, in your own words, speak to God about your willingness to go where he leads you. What joys and/or fears accompany your willingness?
